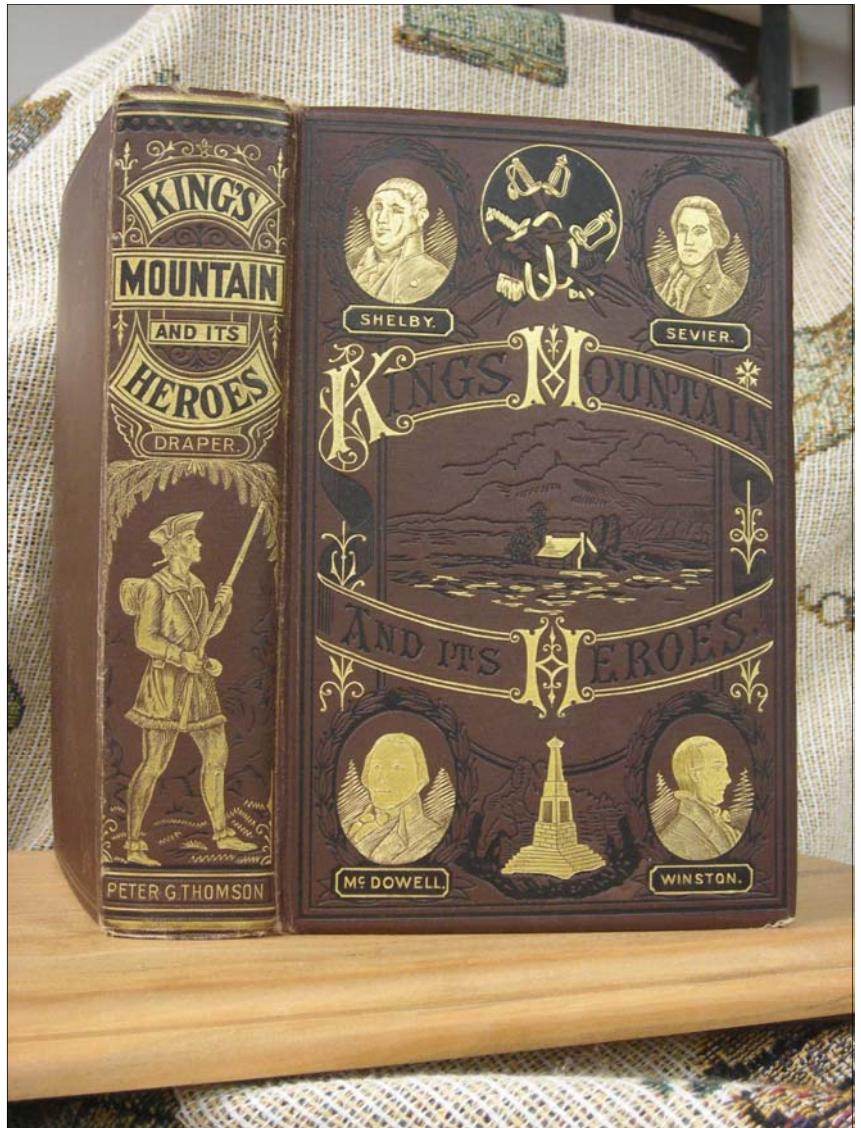
One lot included three frames display cases of brochures and letters from the 1930 150th anniversary celebration at Kings Mountain National Military Park and a walking stick that is carved to commemorate that event.

The other lot was a 1929 (very rare) second printing of Draper's King's Mountain and it's Heroes that was issued by the SAR. The book is in good condition and boasts a leather cover with gold embossed pictures of four of the battle's commanders (Shelby, Sevier, McDowell and Winston) and a "Rifleman" on the spine1.

Both lots—everything they had relating to King's Mountain—were purchased by Fran. OVTA in turn purchased the Draper 2nd edition from Fran for the auction price of \$300 to be the 2008 fundraiser.

As in the past, tickets will be \$5 each or three for \$10.00. The drawing will be on October 7th. Mike Dahl is crafting a display case for the book.
